The drove out with Mrs Gouraud, and will went down town - Mrs Gouraud dined with us at 5 o'clock, and at 8 we went to the theatre - [Haymarket] and saw "The Palace of Truth" and "My Uncle's will" - both of which were excellent, especially the latter - which was one of the most sparkling, witty things I ever saw. -
